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DMJ Expands Greensboro Headquarters

New Office Space Meets Long Term Objectives for the Firm

GREENSBORO – Davenport, Marvin, Joyce & Co., LLP and DMJ Wealth Advisors, LLC today announced the expansion and relocation of its office in Greensboro, North Carolina to a newly constructed office building located inside Green Valley Office Park. Managing Partner **Mike Gillis** says, “Just as we advise our clients, we felt it was important that our firm stay focused on the best long-term strategies and objectives for DMJ.” **Gillis** continues, “Along with our locations in Sanford and Burlington, it provides us with a stronger regional presence as we work on behalf of clients throughout North Carolina,” he said.

In response to today’s economic climate, DMJ clients are receiving frequent communications from the firm and employing specialized management consulting services from DMJ’s financial and accounting professionals.
